

REPORT OF THE SESSION

OHRID (Macedonia)

September 5 to 11, 2021

The Balkans Summer University too in Ohrid, North Macedonia from 5 to 11 september 2021, organised by CIFE in partnership with the Faculty of Tourism and Hospitality of St Kliment Ohridski University.

The foreign candidates were accommodated in a small hotel, very close to the University, the very nice Lake of Ohrid and close to the old city too. The Faculty building where the academic programme took place was only a few steps away.





The central theme of this English-spoken academic programme "Sustainable development and environment protection in the Balkans Region" was very pertinent, especially in this country where the environment protection is a subject of great importance and made possible to approach many different topics associated with the environment and its various problems.

During the approximately 30 hours of lectures, debates and discussions that the programme was composed of, international experts from both Macedonia and abroad paid special attention to a wide range of relevant topics.

13 participants were registered in this programme but only 3 of the North Macedonian candidates were present throughout the duration of the work, so the definitive group was composed of 9 candidates that constituted a diverse group in terms of nationality, age, educational and professional background. They all took advantage of this diversity and appreciated the role of the local students during their free time. During the week, the group also enjoyed very interesting walking tours, guided by our good guide and friend, Kliment, who guided them through the picturesque town of Ohrid. Everyone was amazed by the historical character of the city and agreed that even after these walks, there still was much left to discover.

All the candidates successfully completed the programme and received a certificate of participation. Those who wished to acquire ECTS Credits also took an oral exam. At the end of the session, the students were invited to fill out an evaluation form that showed a great satisfaction.

CIFE warmly thanks the Faculty of Tourism and Hospitality for its collaboration in organising this second Balkans Summer University in Ohrid and hopes to work together again in the future.

Despite the difficulties due to the sanitary situation, the program was successfully carried out to the satisfaction of the group. This edition has once again been very much appreciated, as demonstrated by the overall student satisfaction rate of 93 %.

Except for the local students who stayed in their own apartments, the participants were comfortably accommodated in a small hotel very close to the university. Even though the pandemic non allowed hotels to propose breakfast in the dining, our students had the chance to served individuly in their rooms. Even if it was less comfortable, this solution was found at the last moment. Every morning, they only had to cross the road in order to reach the recently renovated classroom of the Faculty of Tourism and Hospitality, where the academic programme took place. For the working lunches, the Faculty invested a lot of effort in providing the students with typically Macedonian meals. After class, the group was invited to visit the beautiful historic town of Ohrid that they reached after a short walk along the famous Lake.

The participants were very satisfied with the relations with the organisers and the administrative assistance before and during the programme. CIFE's personal approach and Mr Trajkov's efforts on behalf of the Faculty did not go unnoticed. Regarding the academic programme, the studentsagreed that it was interesting as they learnt a lot about the history, culture and politics of this country.

When it comes to the cultural activities, the students had nothing but good things to say about the walking tour during which our professional guide Kliment introduced them to the rich history of Ohrid. For the last day of the Summer University, they had the opportunity to visit the beautiful St Naum Monastery by a private boat. A few students suggested including more similar activities in the programme in order to facilitate the group dynamics as much as possible.
